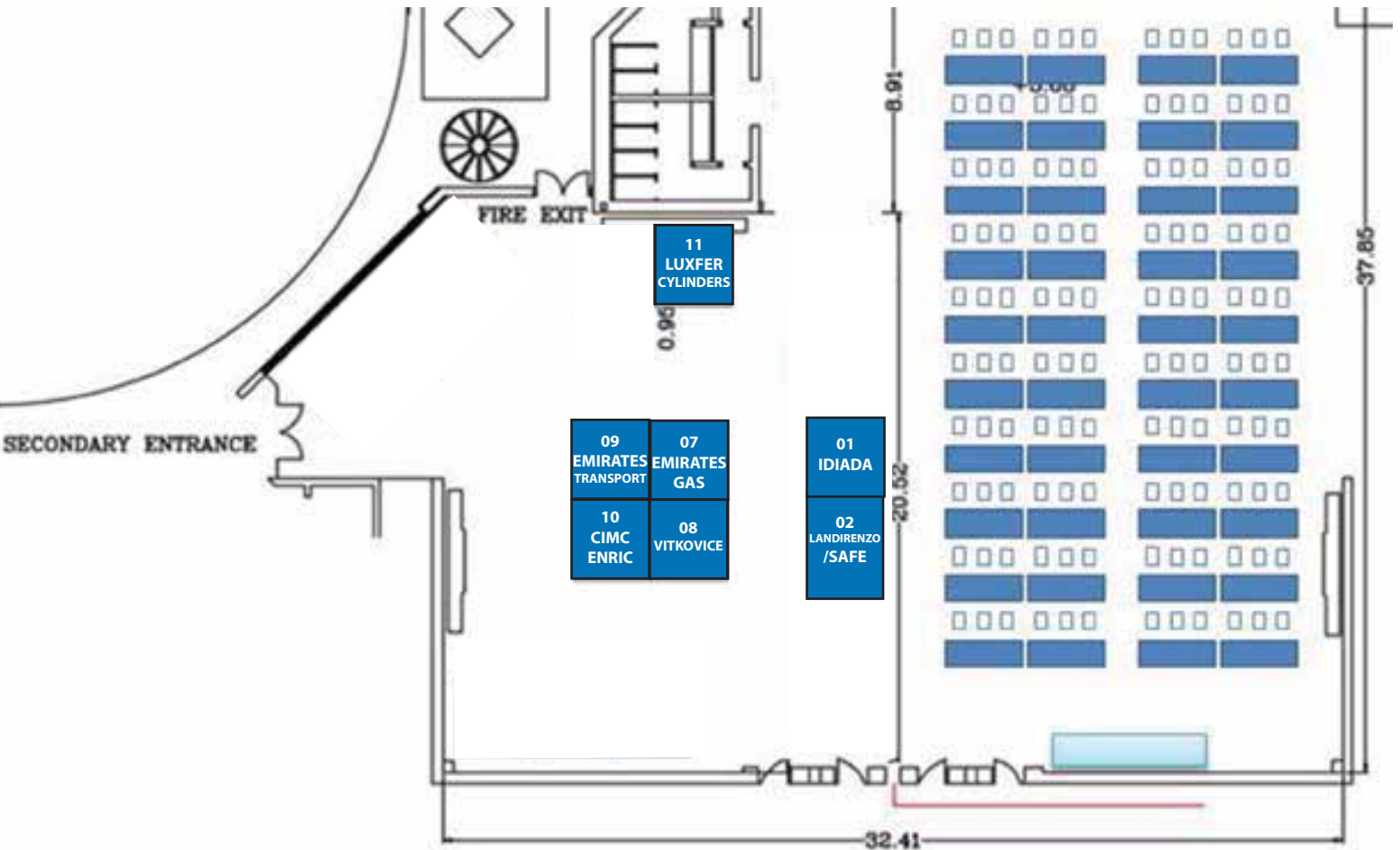

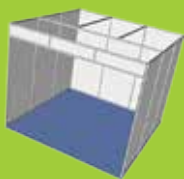
EXHIBITION FLOORPLAN | FALCON BALLROOM
